IBT scores between 68-78; or PBT scores between 500-549; or an IELTS score of 6.0; or PTE Academic scores between 50-58 allow for possible admittance to the American Studies Program or for forwarding to the English Language Center at Michigan State University. These base requirements may change without notice.

- Paper Based TOEFL (PBT) 550, with no subscore below 52
- Internet Based TOEFL (IBT) 79, with no subscore below 17

**IELTS Requirements**

- Score of 6.5 or higher

**Pearson Test of Academic English (PTE Academic)**

- Score of 59 or higher

**Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE)**

- Score of 180 or higher

**DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst)**

- Score of B.2 or higher

**Vitnemål (Norwegian Upper Secondary School Certificate)**

- A 4.0 GPA in English waives English Proficiency requirements

**The American Studies Program**
